

CM Yogi orders action against 73 officers

Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath ordered action against 73 officers who failed to resolve people's problems and were slow in implementing his directive.

A senior official told The Pioneer on Thursday that Yogi took action against the officers found indulging in obstruction of justice. "Notices have been issued to 73 officers who performed the worst in resolving people's problems. The action was suggested when they failed to give satisfactory answers," the official said.

Among the officers who have been issued notices are 10 departmental heads, five commissioners, 10 DMs, five vice-



chairmen of the development authorities, five municipal commissioners, and 10 tehsil officials.

Besides, the official said that clarification was sought from three ADGs, five IGs and DIGs, the heads of three

police commissionerates, SSPs and SPs, and the heads of 10 police stations.

Yogi had earlier ordered officials concerned to submit a report on the complaints received, resolved along with action taken under Thana/Tehsil Diwas. In the directive, he had said that resolving every grievance was the utmost priority of the government.

"The CM had asked the officials to submit a detailed report regarding complaints received, resolved, and pending cases on the Integrated Grievance Redressal System (IGRS), tehsils and police stations without delay. Those who failed to do so were punished," the official said.

UPSSSF personnel deployed at Lok Bhawan

The Uttar Pradesh Special Security Force (UPSSSF) has been tasked with guarding the Chief Minister's Office (Lok Bhawan). UPSSSF personnel have been deployed at all the three gates of Lok Bhawan. All these jawans are equipped with state-of-the-art weapons.

Till now, UP Police and UP Secretariat security personnel were deployed in the security of Lok Bhawan. A unit of UPSSSF has been prepared and 52 personnel deployed for the purpose.

DCP (Central Lucknow) Aparna Rajat Kaushik said Lucknow police and PAC had reviewed the security of Lok Bhawan on Wednesday. After the review, it was decided that the UPSSSF would guard all the three entry gates of Lok Bhawan. A unit of UPSSSF was deployed on Thursday. The



unit comprises eight sub-inspectors and 48 constables. They will be posted in two shifts. The DCP said that the UPSSSF personnel deployed at Lok Bhawan have advanced versions of later security gadgets. She said the personnel of UP Police, Arms Force and PAC have been included in this force. All the personnel were imparted a 90-day training in Sitapur.

The Uttar Pradesh government has formed a special security force for the security of major places of the state capital such as Lok Bhawan, Vidhan Bhawan, airport, court premises, metro stations and big commercial establishments. Five units of this force have been prepared.

In September 2020, the Yogi Adityanath government in Uttar Pradesh had issued a notification to constitute the UPSSSF which is headed by ADG (PAC) S Pratap Kumar.

This force will not require a magistrate's order or warrant to conduct a search operation or arrest under special cir-

cumstances. These powers will be governed through a set of rules made by the state government. The UPSSSF has been formed on the basis of the Allahabad High Court orders.

The HC had expressed its displeasure over security in civil courts in December 2019 in the wake of firing incidents in the courts of Bijnor and Muzaffarnagar.

Ghazipur boat tragedy: Six bodies fished out so far

A total of six bodies have been fished out in the Ghazipur incident in which more than 17 people were feared drowned after a boat capsized in Athata village of the district on Wednesday evening.

The death toll went up to six on Thursday after the recovery of two more bodies. Union Minister of State (Education) Annapurna Devi, who was on a visit to the district, expressed grief

over the incident and assured all possible help. Ghazipur DM Mangla Prasad Singh said: "Six people have died so far in the boat accident in Athata village of the flood-affected Sevarai tehsil. Boats are being used by the administration to ferry flood victims in the affected areas and the boat that capsized was medium in size."

"According to the sailor, the boat was spacious enough to comfortably accommodate but it capsized when there were only 17 people,

including the elderly, women and children. When the water was still, people got distracted due to the sight of a snake and according to the sailor, a person panicked and jumped into the water. Due to this, the boat overturned. The bodies of two people were recovered on Wednesday evening. Today, four more bodies have been fished out. Many people are still missing." Many officers, including the SP and DM, were present on the spot and a team of divers was engaged in search of the missing people.

ANTF prepares roadmap for complete eradication of illegal drug trade in UP

Lucknow (PNS): Chies issued instructions for tightening the noose around the dark web of the internet in the campaign against illegal drug trade in the state.

As per the directions of the chief minister, the newly-formed Anti Narcotics Task Force (ANTF) has prepared a roadmap for complete eradication of illegal drug trade through the dark web in the state and the process of implementation has been started. ANTF will be the first wing of police in Uttar Pradesh to crack down on the dark web.

According to an official communiqué released on Thursday morning, on the instructions of CM Yogi, a campaign is being run against drug mafia across the state and under this, ANTF has been formed. Synthetic narcotics and psychotropic drugs are supplied through the dark web, social media and crypto currency by misusing technology.

CM Yogi has recently assigned the task to ANTF to stop it in the state. Apart from this, legal opium is cultivated in Barabanki, Faizabad, Shahjahanpur, Badaun, 2Bareilly, Ghazipur, Mau and Rae Bareilly districts. In view of this, Yogi has given instructions to ANTF to keep an eye on ille-

One accused in murder case of bank manager's wife, son ends life

In a dramatic turn of events, one of the killers of a bank manager's wife and son in Meerut committed suicide before police could arrest him.

This sensational disclosure was made by the Meerut police who claimed to have cracked the case on Thursday. They claimed that the eight months pregnant wife and five-year-old son of the Punjab National Bank manager in Hastinapur were murdered over a family dispute.

"The murder of the bank manager's wife Shikha and son Rudransh in Hastinapur was executed by his own brother-in-law Harish along with his two friends," Meerut police claimed while also confirming that one of the accused ended life fearing arrest.

The police said that during Harish's interrogation, it surfaced that after committing the murder, the two accused reached Noida via Meerut on Shikha's scooter.

They claimed that Ravi, an accused in this case whom they were looking for, shot himself in Hapur on Thursday morning. The accused took this step after the arrest of the bank manager's brother-in-law.

The house of PNB (Jalilpur, Bijnor) manager Sandeep Kumar is near Ramlila Ground in Hastinapur. On Monday, Sandeep's pregnant wife Shikha and five-year-old son Rudransh were murdered. The bodies were recovered from bed boxes in separate rooms. The miscreants had also locked the main gate of the house before fleeing. e nabbed on the basis of call detail records and CCTV footage.
